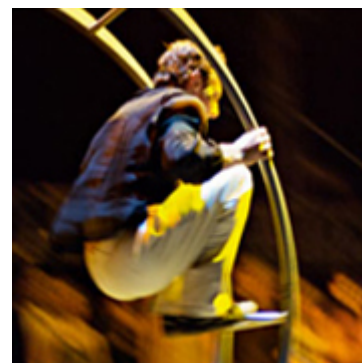


No Fit State Circus

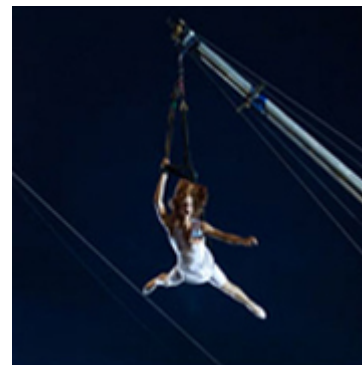
